

# **Robbery -- Second NYPL 160.10 & Third Degree NYPL 160.05**

# **Statutes**

## **§ 160.10 Robbery in the second degree.**

**A person is guilty of robbery in the second degree when he forcibly steals property and when:**

**1. He is aided by another person actually present; or**

**2. In the course of the commission of the crime or of immediate flight**

**therefrom, he or another participant in the crime:**

**(a) Causes physical injury to any person who is not a participant in the crime; or**

**(b) Displays what appears to be a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun, machine gun or other firearm; or**

**3. The property consists of a motor vehicle, as defined in section one hundred twenty-five of the vehicle and traffic law.**

**Robbery in the second degree is a class C felony.**

## **§ 160.05 Robbery in the third degree.**

**A person is guilty of robbery in the third degree when he forcibly steals property.**

**Robbery in the third degree is a class D felony.**
